Join other committed environmentalists, river-lovers and friends for this family-friendly day of fun along our river.

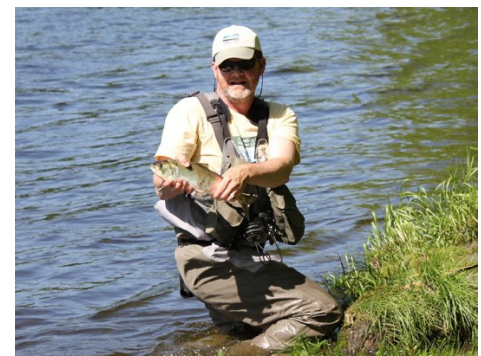
