



### **Water Chestnut Seasonal Intern 2019**

*The Connecticut River Conservancy (CRC) seeks motivated individuals to assist with our Community Science program that manages European Water Chestnut in the Connecticut River Watershed in Connecticut and Massachusetts.*

The ideal candidates will have a passion for the environment, have paddling experience, and enjoy recruiting and managing volunteers. These interns will be responsible for on-water volunteer pull events in the Northern Connecticut area and in Massachusetts, as well as data collection and maintenance.

The positions are supervised by seasonal managers and require a valid driver's license and own vehicle. Work occurs in the evening and on weekends and begins in early June and continues through early August. A boat is provided as needed. Positions come with a stipend.
