The Connecticut River Conservancy (CRC) seeks a motivated individual to assist with our Community Science program that manages European Water Chestnut in the Connecticut River Watershed in Connecticut.

The ideal candidate will have a passion for the environment, have paddling experience, and enjoy recruiting and managing volunteers. This person will be responsible for on-water volunteer pull events in the Middletown, Glastonbury and South Windsor area as well as data collection and maintenance.

The position is supervised by a seasonal manager and requires a valid driver's license and own vehicle. Work occurs in the evening and on weekends and begins in early June and continues through early August. A boat is provided as needed. Position comes with a stipend.

- Ability and interest in getting out on the river
